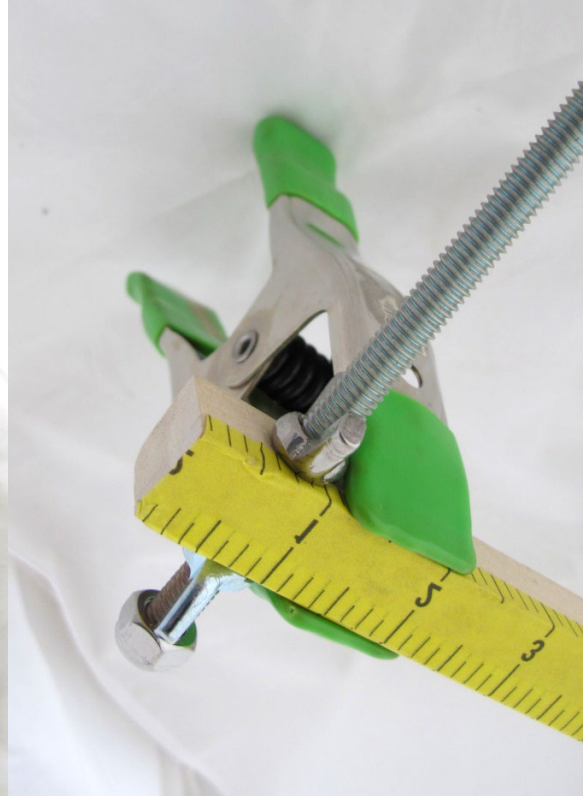
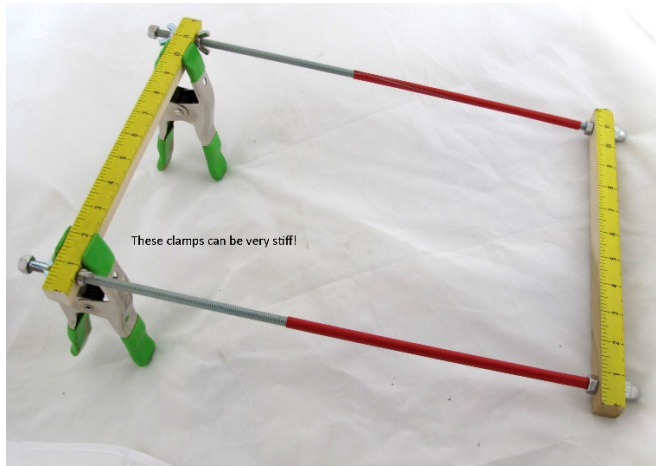
One easy stand to find is your lap with the loom leaning against a table edge or wall.



Tabletop easels can be purchased at art and craft supply stores. The easels can often be purchased on sale and come in a variety of sizes and materials.



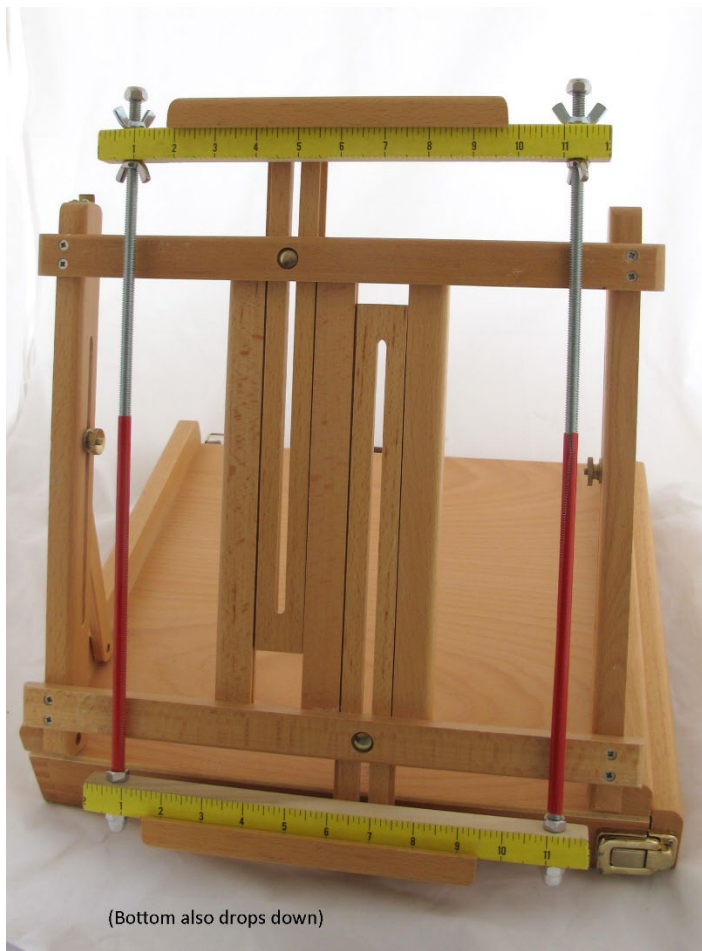
Quick Release Clamps in a variety positions.
